Mayor Porter called the meeting to order.

Mayor Porter updated council on needing to contact the city attorney to write up the needed documentation that pertains to the easement, that the city has no records for when it was added. Then, the city can proceed with establishing appropriate property lines at the ballpark lots and abandon it to share with other property owners. Tabled.
