

Douglas City Council met on May 05, 2026, at 7:00 pm. Mayor Porter and Council Members Narum and Zuck present. Absent were Carlson, and Riemer.

Mayor Porter called meeting to order

Meeting minutes approved and accepted as read.

Discussion was held on the bids for the ballfield, it was advertised in the paper and will continue until the June 17<sup>th</sup> deadline. If none are received by June 17<sup>th</sup>, the city will advertise and set a new closed bid date.

Mayor Porter updated council on the RV Park. The sewer line was extended, three new water hydrants were installed, and the parking areas were extended. The RV spot parking area is now gravel and level. Discussed was the need for the park to have a small dumpster for guests to utilize for seasonal use. Nerem motioned to approve. Zuck second. Vote all ayes. m/c/a. Ottertail can install a streetlight at no cost to the city. Zuck motioned to approve. Nerem second. Vote all ayes. m/c/a. First District Health will be doing an inspection at the park for the City's Permit to operate, mid-month.

Council discussed requesting gaming funds to replace the electrical boxes on the RV Park posts that need updated, and to build a fence. Also, to offset some of the unexpected costs for the sewer extension that was needed, as well as a new meter and repair needed by NPRWD. It is council consensus to submit a request.

Financial reports for April and Bills to pay in May were presented. Zuck motioned to approve. Nerem second. Vote all ayes. m/c/a.
